Introduction

Transport Pro integrates with Trucker Tools to help you automate carrier tracking. Users can order the tracking directly from the Transport Pro system and will receive automatic updates into the TMS, eliminating the need to work from two separate systems. This guide will show you how to order the tracking, and how the updates work.

What We Need From You to Set it up


To get the integration set up, we will need:

- Your API Key
- Partner ID

Your Trucker Tools rep will provide these for you.


Order Tracking From Transport Pro

Once the integration has been enabled, you will see the Trucker Tools logo on the Track & Trace screen in Transport Pro. You can open up the Track & Trace window from either the Planned Loads or Dispatched Loads sections on the Freight Operations Dashboard.





When you click on the Trucker Tools logo, a small window will open and prompt you to enter the required information, and submit the tracking order. When ready, click the "Submit Order" button. As soon as you click submit, the order is successfully sent to Trucker Tools.






See the Automated Updates in Transport Pro

Now that the tracking has been requested, and as soon as the carrier accepts the request, the tracking begins. By default, location updates flow in automatically into Transport Pro every 15 minutes.

You will see these updates flow into the Track & Trace window, where you can view the pings on the map, or you can click the "Show Locations" tab to view the updates in a list format.



Location updates will also be displayed in the "Last Location" column in the Planned and Dispatched Loads sections of the Freight Operations Dashboard.
